





# Am I like a horse?

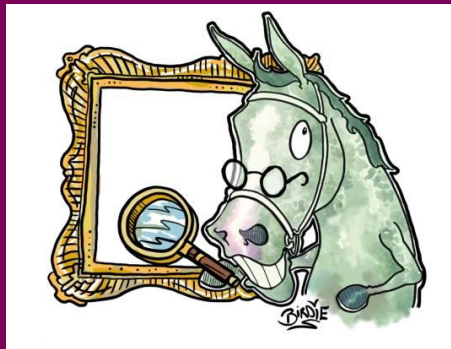
Visit the galleries in the Trainer's House to find out. If you have time, you could visit the horses in the Rothschild Yard.
