Find each object. How does it make you feel? Why?

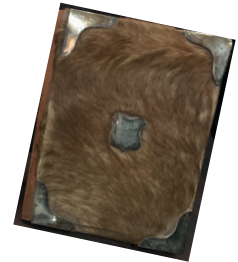
Draw a line to join the image to the emoji.
