### Your Wedding

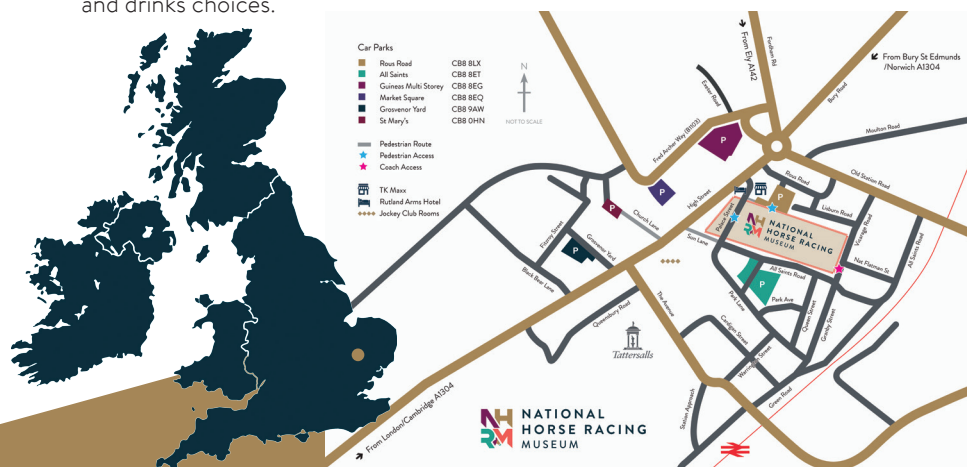
