

TERMS OF HIRE & DISCLAIMER FOR THE HIRE OF LITTLE HOOVES SOFT PLAY

- Little Hooves Soft Play equipment is only suitable for children under the age of 5 years old.
- A responsible adult (over 18 years old) must supervise at all times.
- Please ensure the equipment is kept in a clean condition - all equipment will be cleaned before and after the hire by our event staff.
- No food, drink or chewing gum is allowed on or near any of the soft play equipment.
- Glasses, jewellery, badges **MUST** be removed before using the soft play. No face paints, party poppers, powder cannons, coloured streamers or silly string to be used either on or near the soft play equipment.
- Socks must be worn - no bare feet on the soft play equipment.
- Little Hooves Soft Play and equipment. (These can create staining on the vinyl).
- Always ensure that you limit numbers according to the age and size of children using the the soft play equipment.
- Strictly no shoes at any time. Shoes must be removed at the entrance of the soft play. Adults entering the soft play area must remove their shoes.
- Any damage to the equipment must be reported to National Horseracing Museum staff as soon as possible. Additional charges will apply if equipment is damaged or broken, soiled equipment must be cleaned immediately by the hirer.

THE BUBBLE HOUSE

- Balloons must be provided by the hirer and requires approximately 100 balloons. It's recommended to not overly inflated.
- Please follow the Bubble House instruction sheet - this will be provided in advance of your session hire.
- The Bubble House is powered from a power outlet, the hirer is responsible for powering up the equipment, and keeping area clear of obstruction.
- The recommended capacity for the Bubble House is 4 to 5 people.

JOHN LAMBTON ROOM HIRE

- Crockery, cutlery, glassware and linen are not provided.
- Access to the kitchen is peremitted but we kindly request the oven is not used.
- The hirer is responsible for clearing up and removing any rubbish. Rubbish bags are not provided.
- No pets allowed.
- A strict No Smoking or vaping policy must be adhered to at all times.
- A first aid kit is located in the John Lambton Room kitchen.
